Medication: The analgesic medication regimen we recommend following endodontic treatment helps

prevent pain and/or swelling. For this reason, it is important to observe the following instructions whether or not you experience discomfort:
Recommended Schedule and Dosage:
Take 200 mg ibuprofen (ie. Motrin, Advil, etc.) tablets every six hours after treatment. (take 3-4 tablets per doctor's instructions)
Take 2 Extra Strength Tylenol tablets three hours after each dose of ibuprofen.
Note of caution: Do not take the Tylenol at the same time as the ibuprofen, or you may experience an adverse reaction.
Follow the instructions given for 72 hours following treatment.
Eating: The tooth will be sore for a few days following endodontic treatment. Eat soft foods until the final restoration is placed on the tooth.
Final Treatment: Most teeth that have had endodontic treatment need to be permanently restored with a crown to avoid the tooth breaking. Please contact us to make an appointment for the crown if you have not already.
